Claes Oldenburg – Food Sculptures

Claes Oldenburg is an American sculptor and Pop Artist, best known for his public art installations typically featuring large replicas of everyday objects. He created soft food sculptures using fabrics and paint.



In 1957, **Oldenburg** create his first "soft sculpture," Sausage, a free-hanging woman's stocking stuffed with newspaper.

Materials you could use.....recycling is best!

- Card – cardboard, paper plates
- Paper – all varieties – plain, coloured, newspaper, magazines, tissue paper, parcel paper, scrap gift wrap....
- Recycle materials (eg kitchen waste) plastic boxes, egg/cereal boxes, milk cartons...

Other useful equipment

- Tape (masking tape or sellotape)
- Glue – glue sticks, pva, glue guns
- Scissors
